Fees

Domestic students

There is **no out of pocket fee** for regular GP consults for domestic students with Medicare cards. Fees do apply for vaccines.

International students

There is **no out of pocket fee** to international students with Allianz cover. Fees do apply for vaccines.

Staff

We apply a modest staff fee to offer the convenience of on-campus health care and support our medical practitioners to deliver a high quality service. Fees as follows:

Standard consultation	\$75*
Long consultation	\$110*
Extended consultation	\$145*

*Less than \$40 out-of-pocket per consult for staff after Medicare rebate. Concession Card holders are bulk-billed.

Fees do apply for vaccines.

Please pay in full on the day of consultation. The clinic accepts cash, Visa, Mastercard and EFTPOS.

Appointments

Bookings

When making a booking please request a:

- standard appointment (15 min) or
- long appointment (e.g. travel consult, occupational health, or multiple issues)
- separate appointment for each patient

We're open Monday to Friday 8:30am - 5:00pm.

After hours

If you require medical care after hours you can contact the National Home Doctor Service on **13 74 25**.

Travel health consults

Contact us at least six weeks before departure to allow for your vaccination schedule.

You will need to provide copies of your itinerary and vaccination history.

In an emergency call 000

(e.g. severe chest pain, heavy blood loss, difficulty breathing)



Cancelling your appointment

Please give at least three hours notice if cancelling or rescheduling your appointment. You may be charged a fee if you fail to notify the clinic.

What to bring

You will need your Medicare Card, student or staff ID, and health insurance details where applicable. See over page for fee information.
